

Formats for the evaluation of a tutorial.

Criteria	Notes	Present Y/N
Preparation	Is there evidence of preparation for the tutorial by either side, either in content or in stated aims?	
Content	Was the content of the tutorial appropriate, relevant and interesting?	
Assessment /Feedback	Was there evidence of an assessment of the content being learnt or understood and was this information fed back to the learner?	
Achievable	Was the stated aim of the tutorial achievable in the time allotted?	
Dialogue	Was there a dialogue in which was demonstrated appropriate questioning, answering, listening and summarising skills?	
Learner centred	Was the tutorial centred around the needs of the learner or the agenda of the teacher?	

1. There was evidence of preparation	O - O - O - O - O - O - O	There was no clear evidence of any preparation
2. The content was interesting, relevant and appropriate	O - O - O - O - O - O - O	The content was boring, irrelevant and inappropriate
3. That learning had occurred was assessed and the result fed back.	O - O - O - O - O - O - O	No attempt was made to assess if learning had occurred.
4. The stated aim was achievable in the allotted time.	O - O - O - O - O - O - O	It was impossible for the stated aim to be achieved in the time allowed.
5. There was dialogue in which the teacher demonstrated good questioning, answering, listening, and summarising skills.	O - O - O - O - O - O - O	Questions and answers were inappropriate, listening was limited and summarising poor.
6. The tutorial was centred around the needs of the learner.	O - O - O - O - O - O - O	The tutorial centred around the teachers agenda.
