What is the purpose of these sessions?

The Path to Certification (CCT)

- You need:
- To Pass a KNOWLEDGE exam (AKT)
- To be able to COMMUNICATE and DEMONSTRATE KNOWLEDGE and CLINICAL MANAGEMENT (CSA exam)
- To FUNCTION as a GP in a GP SETTING (WPBA, MSF, PSQ, Audit, CEPS) and document acheivement of skills, competencies and curriculum coverage in the eportfolio

- 10% health informatics & administrative issues





Out of Hours Sessions in ST2 (is changing)

- You need to document 36 hours of working outside daytime hours in the eportfolio in ST2 during your GP Plus or GP only post and label them as 'Out of Hours session'. Include a visible tally of the hours you have done so the ARCP panel can easily see it
- If you are not doing a post that offers on-call then you will need to contact the local Out of Hours Service and ask them to schedule the sessions for you
