What does the General Election Result mean for the NHS?

'Strengthening Our NHS'

- £33.9 billion funding boost for the NHS (by 2023-24)
- (£2.3 billion of this going to Mental Health Services)
- £6.2 billion invested now
- 20 Hospitals are being upgraded
- 40 new Hospitals will be built
- 78 Hospitals will get new MRI, CT and Mammography Screening machines
- Doctors will see their pay increase
- 5 new Medical Schools
- 50,000 more nurses, £5-8000 student maintenance grants
- Improve staff morale with more funding for CPD and more supportive Hospital Management

Also in the 2019 Manifesto

- 6000 more Doctors in General Practice
- 26000 more Primary Care Professionals (MSK, Pharmacists)
- 7500 extra Nurse Associates
- 50 million extra GP surgery appointments
- The NHS Visa to encourage overseas recruitment

- Not in the Manifesto but announced:
- A Childhood Vaccination Reminder system
- An onslaught against hard to cure diseases
- Development of Community Mental Health, 1000 extra staff
- An extra £975 million for mental health services
- An extra £1.8 billion for Hospitals
