


Proposed local SOX process

- Link up with another Trainer in another Practice who is hosting a ST3
- Speak to the trainer about what support they would benefit from in advance
- Trainee will need to share 3 recordings on 14fish
- Analyse 2-3 videos/audio recordings guest trainer, actual trainer and trainee to all mark using the RAG rating grid in advance
- Meet for around 2 hours to discuss calibration, emergent themes and an exam preparation strategy eg areas of the consultation to concentrate on and tips, discussing potential exam timing
- Complete an educator note, using the Local SOX Proforma about the strategy
