## August 2017 ST1 Intake

- 20 places
- 20 Trainees allocated
- + 1 Broad-Based Trainee into ST2
- + 1 Inter Deanery Transfer into ST3
- + Several extension Trainees every 6 months





## Deferrals, LTFT and ATCF

- Trainees are allowed to defer the start of Training by 3 – 12 months
- 1 has deferred until August 2018
- 5 Trainees have deferred until Feb 2018
- 1 Trainee has started as LTFT
- 2 Trainees have a shortened programme of 2.5 years due to the **Accreditation of Transferable Competencies Framework**

## Trainers and Training Practices


- 16 Training Practices ↑
- 30 GP Trainers ↑
- 10 GP Plus posts per 6 months ↑



## Exam Pass Rates

- 1<sup>st</sup> time pass for AKT and CSA 90 – 95%
- FourteenFish AKT Package for AKT and now CSA + DRC and Mock CSA
- Trainee needing to extend Training is uncommon

## Chronic Disease Management Exposure

- Highlighted as an issue in Oct 2016 GMC/HEE NW Visit
  - ST3 Trainees formally surveyed in June 2017
  - Most said they had not had enough exposure

## Out of Hours and New JD contract


- ST2 in a GP plus post is paid to do 6 hours a month of 'Out of Hours'
- Anything above this is funded by the provider
- Current issue with Hospice GP Plus Trainees and Hospice Rota



## Out of Hours and New JD contract

- Weekly hours must not go above 40 on average
- When they do an OOH session time needs to be given back in the week
- Bardoc are trying to give Trainees 2-3 months notice of shifts so practices have enough notice

## ARCP Panels

- GP Trainers can be panel members
  - It is relatively well paid and it is very useful for a Trainer
  - 9 -5 or AM or PM at PP3
  - Panel A – Trainee does not attend
  - Panel B – Trainee attends
  - £ per eportfolio screened + for attending
