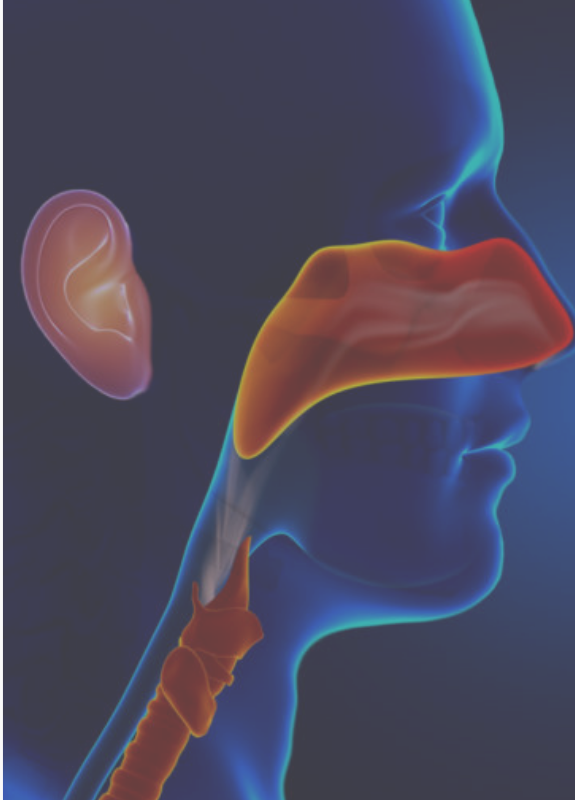

ABOUT THE COURSE

This unique course aims to provide practical tips for managing common ENT problems in the primary care. The course will also cover Head & Neck Red flags, when to refer to secondary care and how urgently.

The program includes interactive lectures (mostly pictures and videos rather than written slides) and case-based discussions.

In the afternoon, every candidate will perform otoscopic examination on simulator, tuning fork tests and participate in case-based discussions. Otoscopy simulators will allow candidates to identify common ear findings like cholesteatoma, glue ear, otitis externa, ear drum perforation, tympanosclerosis etc.
