

# Notifiable diseases

## Diseases that are routinely immunised against:

- Diphtheria
- Tetanus
- Acute poliomyelitis
- Whooping cough
- Meningococcal septicaemia
- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella

## Diseases related to foreign travel:

- Acute infectious hepatitis
- Brucellosis
- Cholera
- Enteric fever (typhoid or paratyphoid fever)
- Rabies
- Yellow fever
- Legionnaires' disease
- Malaria
- Typhus

## Poisoning:

- Anthrax
- Botulism
- Food poisoning
- Infectious bloody diarrhoea

## Classical diseases:

- Leprosy
- Plague
- Smallpox
- Tuberculosis

- Acute encephalitis
- Acute meningitis
- Haemolytic uraemic syndrome (HUS)
