# **Duties of the post**

The post encompasses all aspects of orthopaedics.

The GPST trainees will be largely ward based and will be responsible for daily ward rounds and geneal care of ward patients.

In addition they will be expected to provide first on call cover for A&E department referrals with the support of a SpR. They will also attend clinics and theatre sessions, although these will be mainly for teaching and experience.

#### On Call

On call is shared across general and orthopaedic surgery. The GPST will have the cover of an SPR.

#### **Clinical Governance**

The department has regular audit meetings. The GPST will be expected to collect morbidity and mortality data for these and to present. In addition they should attempt to participate in one audit project in the six months. Mr S Jari is in charge of audit in the department.

## Purpose of the post:

The overall aims will be:-

- To gain an understanding of the principles of orthopaedics
- To be able to examine the joints and the musculoskeletal system in a confident and precise manner. This includes back pain and spinal problems.
- To learn about orthogeriatric medicine
- To be able to advise patients attending your clinic when your are a GP not just in diagnosis and treatment but also to understand the risks and benefits of various orthopaedic procedures
- For the enthusiast to learn about joint injections and minor ops

# **Educational content:**

Our scheme of educational activities is appended. Attendance at clinic and theatre is normally in a supernumerary role and will thus provide a learning opportunity. We have daily trauma meetings and weekly X ray meetings GP training half day is protected and duties are covered by the other trainees.
