When voting for your colleagues' QI projects and presentations, please consider the following themes:

- Relevance and/ or innovative
- If evidence of change/ improvement from the project, meaningful consideration of ways to make change(s) sustainable
- If improvement was not demonstrated, meaningful consideration of why this may be the case and potential solutions
- Problem solving approach to challenges/ issues
- Potential for transferability to other practices
- Evidence of personal reflection and learning from QI process
- Engaging, clear, interesting presentation
